

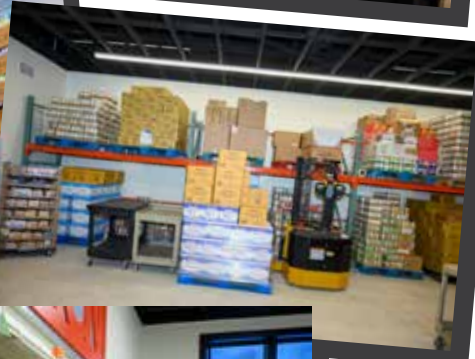

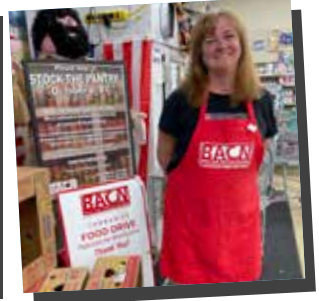

# 2022 Services In Review



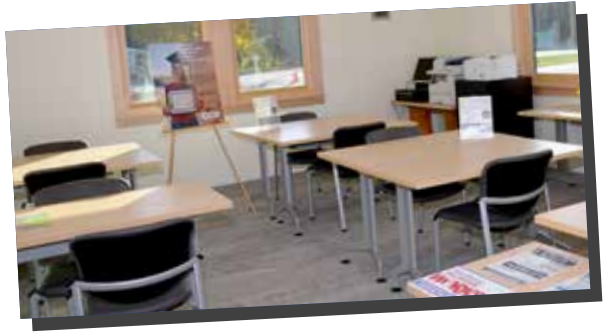
**4,302** Chris and Theresa Webber Food Pantry visits and senior bags delivered in partnership with Benzie Senior Resources

**94** Individuals sought their GED or received assistance with employment opportunities through the Foster Family Learning Center

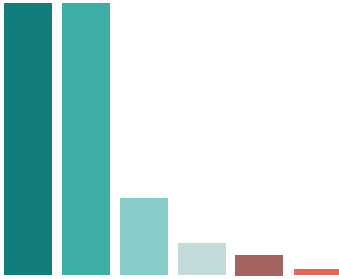


**57** households received financial assistance for transportation, medical, and other unique needs

In October 2022, BACN welcomed community members to celebrate the opening of our new building and BACN's increased capacity to offer new and expanded services to our Neighbors

Due to the generosity of our community, BACN has completed its new facility debt-free

BACN's need for a new facility was driven by an aging, inefficient building that was limiting our capacity to meet community needs. Following numerous studies, BACN engaged Spence Brothers Construction and Environment Architects to collaborate on the evaluation of options and ultimately design and build an 11,300 square foot facility costing \$4.25 million. This total includes all furnishings, fixtures and equipment, as well as \$500,000 for program start-up and long-term building maintenance.
